## for a flawless Suspense Narrative

- The File Name for my document is: **Suspense Narrative – My First & Last Name**
- All comments (from peers/teacher) have been marked “resolved” and none are showing in the margins.
- My font is consistent throughout (the same the whole time) and easy to read.
- My font is approximately 12-point in size (or bigger, if the font I chose is particularly small).
- I do not have any italic font in my piece—not even in the prompt.
- I DO NOT HAVE ANY TEXT WRITTEN IN ALL CAPS. I am better than that.
- My document is double spaced the whole way through.
- My paragraphs do not have an extra space in between them.
- My heading is in the top left-hand corner, and looks as follows:
  - Name (**First & Last Name**)
  - Turn-In Date (**January 21<sup>st</sup>, 2015**)
  - Period
  - Assignment (**Suspense Narrative**)
- I have a catchy title.
- I have between 1000 and 1500 words, not including the prompt.
- All of my paragraphs are indented.
- Each speaker has his or her own paragraph for his or her own dialogue and actions.
- I do not have any giant chunks of dialogue without narration in between.
- I have highlighted all Compositional Risks in yellow.
